If you decide to use these photos, you must ask for permission. The best way to contact me is by e-mail. The e-mail that I will use is sam@sschuetzphotography.com . I will check my e-mail at least two to three times a day. I will respond as soon as possible.

Also, I will ask each and every one who wishes to have their photos taken, to sign a model agreement license. This states that I have your permission to use these photos for online use, for my own personal portfolio, and advertisement in the future. If I have not asked you to do so, that is because I have gotten your permission to post photos onto the site. I will not use these photos without prior permission from the client. I will not alter these photos in any way, shape, or forms that will discriminate, hurt, or force any religious beliefs unto said person.

Any photos that are listed on the site, used on social media, or printed professionally will have some form of copyright symbol and a form of identification. These photos do not at this time but they will very shortly.
